Mediation is a confidential process whereby a neutral third-party (a mediator) follows standard guidelines to assist parties to reach a settlement.

Benefits of mediation are affordability, timely resolution, confidentiality, and preservation of the relationship between parties.

Successful mediators are solution oriented, critical thinkers, patient, persistent, effective listeners, and adept communicators.

The Mediation Center maintains a roster of volunteer mediators to mediate court-ordered, community referred, and organizational conflicts.

The Mediation Center has mediators specially trained in General Civil, Domestic Relations Mediation, Domestic Violence Mediation, and Juvenile Mediation. For general civil mediation training, applicants must have a high school diploma. For domestic relations training, a mediator must have a bachelor's degree and be a registered civil mediator.
